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Free Tax Preparation Service for Individuals who Qualify for the Earned Income Tax Credit

(Cincinnati, OH) – The Cincinnati-Hamilton County Community Action Agency (CAA) is assisting low- and moderate-income taxpayers in filing their 2009 tax return. The service is free to all individuals who qualify for the Earned Income Tax Credit and will help tax payers avoid paying high and unnecessary fees to commercial tax preparers who charge for rapid anticipation loans.

The EITC initiative is the largest federal anti-poverty program for working families, lifting more children out of poverty than any other federal program. To receive the Earned Income Tax Credit, income must be less than:

- \$43,279 (\$48,279 married filing jointly) with three or more qualifying children;
- \$40,295 (\$45,295 married filing jointly) with two qualifying children;
- \$35,241 (\$40,463 married filing jointly) with one qualifying child;
- \$13,440 (\$18,440 married filing jointly) with no qualifying children.

Assistance is available at CAA, located at 1740 Langdon Farm Road. Tax volunteers will prepare EITC tax returns through Thursday, April 15, 2010 during the following hours:
